Klaipeda University is a dynamic and growing multidisciplinary institution. It comprises two research institutes – the Institute of Baltic Region History and Archaeology and the Marine Research Institute – along with three faculties: Marine Technology and Natural Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities, and Health Sciences. Additionally, the university has a Business Incubator, a Botanical Garden, Lifelong Learning and STEAM centres, and even its own fleet.

Each year, Klaipeda University educates over 3,000 students, boasts a network of more than 40,000 alumni, and employs around 850 academic and administrative staff. The university aspires to become the leading institution in the Baltic region.

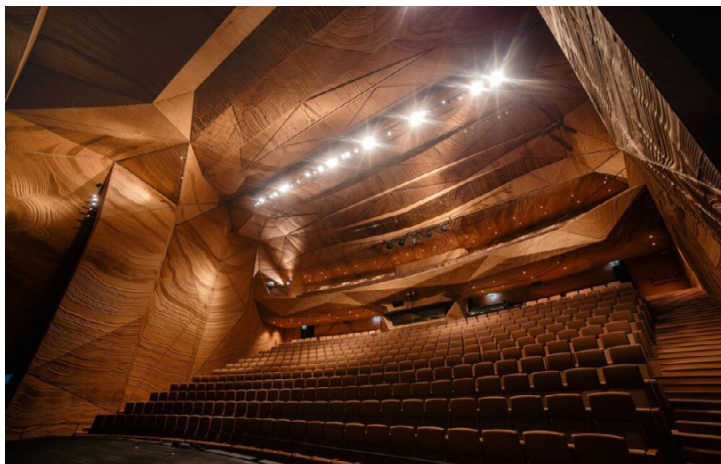
